Pianist, Music Leader, Opening/Closing Song, Opening/Closing Prayer, Talk on Baptism, Priesthood Holder to perform baptism, 2 witnesses, Any special musical numbers, Talk on the Holy Ghost, Melchizedek priesthood holder to perform confirmation, Melchizedek priesthood holders in confirmation circle. Bishopric Member to conduct
